Community Health:

In this program we are covering 30 villages of Rayagada block and 30 nos Village Kashipur of Rayagada, District of Odisha imparting knowledge to the community on health care, HIV/AIDS awareness, mother & Child Health, nutrition etc. We are also focusing Chandbali of Bhadrak district on similar health issues to improve the state of health. IEC materials are used to promote awareness level with target community. In HIV/AIDS program we are focusing in Laximpur Block of Koraput district along with Rayagada and Bhadrak district.



Awareness Against stigma and discrimination:

SCR is working to create awareness in collaboration with different line departments and likeminded organization to bring awareness with the community giving government sponsored benefits. SCR motivated 5 SHG federations and 16 School through the Sensitization and training programmes. They are now involved in providing care and support for HIV infected and affected families.



Adult Education:

To enable 600 SHG members from 30 selected villages in target area to become literate and financially aware with focus to ST, SC and weaker communities. The women beneficiaries are prioritized with various methods.



Economic Enhancement and livelihood:

To empower the community economically through formation and strengthening of SHGs agricultural productivity increased of 750 poor tribal women farmers & male farmers by enhancing knowledge and skills introducing new seeds, techniques linking with different programs in convergence with MGNREGA.



Target imagined in this action:

- Formation and enabling Small holder Farmers’ Groups (FGs) with 20-25 farmers.
- Formation of agriculture cluster to leverage their collective strengths and actions for formation and action of Producer Groups (PG) at area level focusing on doubling production, promote access to markets etc.



- 100 Agri-Entrepreneurs (AE) will be selected and trained in agri-enterprise models. This will include crop choice at different seasons, quality farm inputs, practice of mixed cropping, organic manures, harvesting and storage. The agri-entrepreneurs will be groomed.

- Community Based Organizations will be promoted as registered entities representing small farmers’ interest with grooming to become self-driven and carry forward aspirations even after project period.

- Agri-entrepreneur hubs will be established as a support system for AEs. These hubs will work on economies of scale to access input suppliers at a competitive price at the right time. Government resources will be mobilized through Producer Cooperatives (PC). Business plan will be prepared by PCs considering winner crops, cultivation timing and area, availability of inputs, natural pest management, expert advice on crop management, improvement of soil fertility, storage facility, prospective buyers, expected pricing, required investment, credit support etc. Farmers’ groups will create common assets like water bodies, irrigation facilities, mixed cropping patches, SALT cropping, fruit orchards, and common nurseries.

- Developed cadres within the community to promote CFR /IFR activities for tribal peoples.

- Conducting training on Forest right Act to FRC in 34 villages, which was targeted for 22 villages with plan to expand it to 34 villages.

- Training to community leaders and selected PRI members on social security imparted more than 200 persons till now in 34 villages.

- Promotion of millets and allied activities with processing and marketing training under millet mission.

Local Governance:

To build capacity of 30 village development committee members on local governance about PRI functions.



Campaign against girl child discrimination:

With focus to school children in the locality in broadening their vision on socio-economic-cultural issues in their immediate surroundings with using training modules to train them on the following aspects:

- Adverse effects of child marriage and early marriage and how to curb them.



- Appropriate participation in the education and other welfare programs for the girl child.
- How to defend from sexual exploitations.
- Creation of menstrual hygiene and eradicating social taboos.

Eradication of Child Labor:

Actions taken to eradicate child labour making them aware with focus to vulnerable families. Similarly, we are campaigning against child labor and making the community aware of the evil effects of child labor as it destroys the future of engaged children in child labor. We make door to door visits of Gram panchayats, Teacher's, Anganwadi Worker (AWW) and NGO with help of Government. Social mobilization requires a broad social alliance and strategy partnership between children, families, teacher's, professionals, Social workers, and political polarities and consumers groups. Campaign committees consisting of member of these groups can be formed to carry out the process of mobilization.

Our Future Focus Areas:

Child support and security- Eradication of child labor, Campaign against Girl child Discrimination, Child education for the underprivileged,

Women empowerment- Women SHG formation and strengthening, linkage with Banks and other financial institutions for SHGs, Business opportunity identification of SHG members, Business planning and establishment of micro-enterprises.

Health education and community health-awareness

Community awareness program on personal hygiene for prevention against disease, Awareness on HIV/AIDS and remove taboos around them, Prevention methods against these diseases support services to HIV/AIDS affected persons like sex workers in urban & rural areas.



Income generation and livelihood support services for

Marginal sections- Promote women farmers as small land holding farmers with integrated smart farming, market linkage of small producer groups from farm sector, Capacity building on entrepreneurship and micro-enterprise, Linkage with resource institutions like banks, district industries center etc.



Post disaster relief and rehabilitation work- Relief distribution and reaching out to the most affected vulnerable community during natural disasters like cyclone, extreme rain. Work on the rehabilitation of the most affected families so that they can again start earning and start livelihood which suffered.

Environment protection- Awareness generation among children and youth on importance of forest

and their protection, promote environment friendly farm practices like bio-fertilizers and pesticides and reduce usage of chemical fertilizers and pesticides, with environment friendly actions.

Reducing vulnerability of climate affected marginalized groups like wage workers, marginal farmers etc:

The adverse effects of climate change is most apparent on economically most vulnerable groups. We work with these groups understanding adverse effects taking appropriate action to promote livelihood accordingly.
